

Thomas Heilmann is lawyer, member of the German Parliament and author of the recently published political bestseller NEUSTAAT, in which he, together with other MPs and experts, presents 103 proposals for the fundamental modernisation of the state. Heilmann became known as a co-founder, start-up financier and small shareholder of various international start-ups - including mytoys, Xing, Pixelpark and Facebook. In 1999, he became internet spokesperson of Angela Merkel. In 2012, Heilmann became Senator for Justice and Consumer Protection for the City of Berlin, holding this office until 2016. Since 2017 he is a member of the German Bundestag and also a member of the Digital Agenda Committee and of the board of the CDU/CSU parliamentary group (ruling party). Heilmann heads the parliamentary working group for the future.
